A screen professional with over twenty years' experience in the film and television industries Naomi has produced comedy, drama, documentary, animation and children's programs.

Naomi's credits include ABC blue chip documentary series "The Life Series", the three-time AACTA nominated sitcom "Sammy J & Randy in Ricketts Lane", children's animated comedy series "Winston Steinburger and Sir Dudley Ding Dong" for ABC Me and Teletoon Canada, and the 6-part Comedy Central US / ABC sitcom of "Ronny Chieng: International Student". In 2020 Naomi is executive producing cup stacking documentary "Stackorama!" with Adelaide company Run Wild Productions, and is co-producing with Aquarius Films on their inner city heist comedy-drama "The Unusual Suspects" for SBS.

With a passion for putting female stories firmly in the frame, since 2019 Naomi has actively curated a slate of content for her new mantle, Mischief Media. A self-confessed genre agnostic, Naomi's mission is to elevate female storytellers and stories that seek to challenge, inspire and entertain audiences. In 2020 Mischief Media's first production was the Screenability short film "Safety Net" with director Anthea Williams and writer Julian Larnach, which screened at 2020's Sydney Film Festival and was a finalist for the New Zealand International Film Festival. A feature film based on the work is currently in development.
